Property Update - Sewers

We have been informed by Severn Trent that work to replace the blocked sewer under the road of Cole Street is due to take place from the 10th February 2025. This will include the full closure of the main road and therefore keep an eye on our social pages or website for any further updates in terms of access etc.. In the meantime, Severn Trent are mitigating the issue by visiting our site weekly to clear the sewage drains and for this we thank them. Unfortunately, until the work by Severn Trent is complete, the accessible toilet has been locked out of use due to sewage forcing its way back up the pipe. We will reopen this toilet as soon as we can. If you notice any issues while using the church site, please inform David, our Property Secretary, as soon as possible. Thank you.

Property Update – Winter Work

Our thanks to Gary & David who have completed some more work around the site during January:

- A new fridge has been purchased and fitted into the kitchen as the old one had stopped working.
- Reclaimed plastic panelling has been repurposed adjacent to the cabin to create a lean-to allowing for dry, outdoor storage, the veg patch has been cleared and (with the help from Maria), will soon be sewn.
- Work to the car park including the reinstatement of a bollard and clearing of the gate pin floor holes.
- Vacuuming of the heaters.
- Repairs to the felt on the cabin roof.
